Players may only participate in one of the three League competitions which means that once a player has played for one of their club's teams, they cannot play for any other team even if their original team gets knocked out of the competition. For the semi-final and the final where a club has two or more teams, a player is not eligible to play unless that player has played in at least two League matches for that team.

The team which has the highest aggregate score will be awarded the match. Should the aggregate scores be equal then the team having the most individual winners. If still equal then the team with the player who has the highest differential score. If there is still no clear winner then there will be a one end play off between two players nominated by each team captain and the lead will be tossed for.
